#### Language Requirement (for English program)

Note that we require every applicant to enclose his/her language proficiency certificates such as TOEFL/TOEIC/IELTS.

<Score/Mark/Result requirement>

TOEFL ITP... 500 or above

TOEFL IBT... 70 or above

TOEIC... 750 or above

IELTS... 5.5 or above

Other certificates under CEFR... B2 or above

For [Onsite Area Studies Program conducted in Japanese, JLPT N3 or above](#) is preferred

#### Programs available for exchange students

##### **Undergraduate Program**

##### **Area of Concentration**

Business/Management, Law, Finance, Economics: taught in English

Japanese Language courses (required): taught in both English and Japanese

##### **Grading System**

Japan based. Every course is 2 credits (or 4 ECTS),

but Japanese Language course is 1 credit each (or 2 ECTS)

The grades run from AA to C, and F.

AA is the highest grade and C is the lowest passing grade.

Below C is an F or Fail. (AA... 100-90, A... 89-80, B... 79-70, C... 69-60, F... 59-0)

#### Orientation

The incoming students will have to attend an orientation session which takes place a week before the semester begins. The first half will involve Japanese students taking students to the Ward Office, around the campus and accommodation, and to the city center. The second half of orientation will involve information regarding classes, program calendar, some important schedule and etc..

#### Immigration

The incoming students for this exchange program are required to apply for the International Student VISA. The HUE CIEE will provide the matriculation certificate and certificate of eligibility, which you will need to apply for VISA.

The CIEE staff member will provide the link or access information regarding the website information where incoming students can collect necessary information about their stay.



## General Background

### Food

Lunch is provided in the school cafeteria.

### Transport

On the day the students arrives, one of the CIEE staff members will pick up him/her at either Hiroshima station or Nakasuji station. The detailed pickup information will be given 1-2 weeks prior to arrival.



### Campus facilities

Free access to the Wi-Fi system, computers, study rooms available in the campus. Use of sports facilities\* such as the gym are also available free of charge.

### Housing

CIEE will assign the students to accommodation facilities. Details will be sent from the CIEE once students are confirmed.

### Health Insurance

All international students are required to purchase and hold their own health insurance covering illnesses and accidents during the period of time they stay in Japan. Furthermore, students who stay for two semesters will be required by Law to attain the Japan National Insurance.
