<b>Pre-Sessional English Programme</b>	14 week course: Start date - 17 May 2018 10 week course: Start date - 14 June 2018 6 week course: Start date - 12 July 2018
<b>Application Deadline</b>	Autumn Semester – 15 <sup>th</sup> June Spring Semester – 25 <sup>th</sup> October
<b>Programme requirements</b>	3.0 GPA or its equivalent. Students must have completed at least one year of study at university level by the start of their Bristol studies.

<b>Duration of exchange:</b>	Bristol accepts exchange students both for semester-long exchanges and year-long exchanges, although some departments require full-year exchanges (e.g. Law), whilst others can only accept exchange students for a particular semester (e.g. Economics only accepts full year or Autumn term exchanges).

<b>Departments not open to Study Abroad students</b>	Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry, Community-based Medicine, all post-graduate level units.

<b>Visa Information</b>	<p>Students coming for more than 6 months must apply for a Tier IV General Student Visa. <b>Accommodation</b>	<p>Students applying for Autumn entry are guaranteed a place in University halls of residence. Unfortunately, we cannot guarantee places for Spring entry, but most students are allocated a room in University housing.
